This morning Meridian was conducting a site walk and worker came across a single bone. Shortly after, another bone was discovered.

Agencies notified: SHPD (Archaeologist and Burial Specialist) and KPD to Report. Planning Department to inform.

A site walk inspection was conducted (around 12:30)

With Meridian's Colin Thompson and myself, our geologist Dr. Chuck Blay.

Archaeologist David Buckley, Burial specialist Kauanoe Hoomanawanui, KPD officer Asunción, DOCARE officer Tabanoi. During the site visit, Buckley consulted with Alan Downer and Hinano Rodrigues.

The bones were determined to be of cow and of pig. We were cleared and proceeded. It is my understanding that SHPD will complete a follow up Report on this.

During our morning sitewalk, we came across iwi, which appears to be placed. It has not been verified as human or "inadvertent".

We notified SHPD's Kauai archaeologist, David Buckley. He is enroute to perform a site visit.

We have notified KPD.

We have notified SHPD's Kauai burial specialist, Kauanoë Hoomanawanui. She is coordinating with David Buckley enroute to site visit.

We've ceased working in the vicinity of the area. And await SHPD's visit and guidance. We will keep you abreast of what is determined from the site visit.
